



WHY DID YOU WRITE 'RED WINTER JOURNEY'? WHAT WERE YOUR INSPIRATIONS?

Somebody once asked me if I could go back in time where would I go. I replied I would go back to see how my Great Grandfather X10 and his family lived. I suppose through my research I have done this. Through my research I have found out where abouts he lived in Haworth, Yorkshire.

I never knew much about my roots and neither did my father, so I thought it was important to leave a legacy for my children. Hopefully they and their children will never have to wonder.

HOW DO YOU CREATE OR MODEL YOUR CHARACTERS TO FIT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STORY AND THE EXPECTATIONS OF THE READERS?

This is something I have got better at. I believe my characters in 'Red Winter Journey' are well developed more so than in 'Skulduggery'. I believe it is easier for readers to empathise with them. Some readers have said they couldn't wait to find out if Tommy makes it home after all the trials and tribulations he went through. Then for the story to end like it did, well who saw that coming? I have got a lot better at using hooks to get the reader interested and keep them interested to read on.

WHAT ARE YOUR PLANS FOR YOUR FUTURE BOOKS?

Continue the stories using my ancestors as the main characters; however, I would like to change up and bring some Australiana into my writing. My fourth novel will be called 'Ten Pound Tourist'. It will follow the exploits of Thomas Rushworth's great grandson X9 as he leaves Yorkshire in the 50's to arrive in Victoria to work on a sheep farm. This is the story of my father Jimmy Brown.
